- 2. Principles of constructing actions promoting oral health and prophylactic programs in dentistry. Examples of targeted dental prophylaxis programs according to WHO.
- 3. Outline of the epidemiology of the most important dental diseases of civilization in the field of dentistry: oral cavity cancer, caries, periodontitis.
- 4. Preparation of an action promoting oral health and a program promoting oral health. Assessment of the implementation of such programs.
- 1. Organization of the oral cavity prophylaxis day. Preparation of a targeted prevention program for selected oral pathology in adults and / or children.
