Course information – academic year 2022-2023 for students of the third year

Conditions that each student must meet to get a credit of microbiology and students duties:

- ► Presence on classes with printed (from the website of the Dept. of Microbiology) and supplemented (according to indications) materials for classes is obligatory to get a credit of the class!!!!
- ▶ Lack of prepared materials and failure to prepare for classes will result in failure to get a credit from the given class (students who will get no credit of the class must pass the material within a week in his/her teacher)
- ▶ Lack of three credits from classes at the end of the semester will result in a lack of credit of microbiology course without the possibility of passing the material at the end of semester all these students will not be allowed to attend practical exam and will lose the first term of final exam. All these student will have the opportunity to pass the material from classes in December , then attend practical exam and after passing the practical exam attend final exam, but only within two terms: the second one and commission exam.
- ► Students with sick notes must supplement class materials within a week after the end of the absence from classes, pass the missing material and get a credit of the class in their teacher
- ▶ Sick leaves must be delivered to the teacher for up to 3 days after the end of the absence from classes. In the case of absence on a commission test or exam, sick leave must be submitted to the examiner for up to 3 days from the date of the exam. Original sick notes must be shown to teacher and a copy of a sick note must be delivered to the teacher. This document must include a stamp and the sign of a doctor. Documents of dubious origin will be verified.
- ▶ One day lasting sick notes on the day when there is a class test will not be considered if such students may write the class test with another group of students in another day
- ► Students must not be late on classes (students who will late three time on classes will get an unjustified absence)
- ► Students must follow the safety regulations of classes:
 - a) Students must have a lab cloth before enter the class room
 - b) Students must washed their hands and disinfect before leaving the class room
 - c) Eating and drinking in the class room is absolutely prohibited!!!
- ▶ Usage of mobile phones during classes, retakes and exams is prohibited !!!
- ► According to regulations of our Medical University all lectures are obligatory and absence on the lecture must be justified by a sick note

Class tests:

- 1. There will be three class tests in this semester ten opened questions each. There will be two terms of each class tests first and second. Students who will get no credit of these both terms according to the Regulations of Wrocław Medical University will have to write the test covering all material of microbiology (first and second semester) at the end of semester but before the practical exam.
- 2. If the answer to an open test question is assessed, only the first answers which test command asks will be checked. The remaining answers will not be taken into account, regardless of their possible correctness
- 3. To get a credit of class test student must get min 60%.

Criteria for passing class tests, practical exam and final exam:

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60-67% positive answers – satisfactory
68-75% positive answers – above satisfactory
76-83% positive answers – good
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84-91% positive answers – above good 92-100% positive answers – very good

- 4. Unjustified absence on a class test is equivalent with insufficient grade
- 5. Students cheating or talking during class test will be asked to leave the class room and they will fail the test
- 6. Students with sick notes lasting several days have a right to the first term of a class test but in the designated terms only (according to schedule). Students with sick notes lasting two or more weeks will be considered individually.

The practical exam at the end of the semester will consist of two parts:

- (a) practical reading the read-made slide and evaluating it in the context of a clinical case report.
- (b) theoretical –In this part student will be obligated to give answers to questions concerning the material from this semester (diseases, epidemiology, etiologic agents (bacteria, viruses and fungi), treatment antimicrobials, mechanisms of bacterial resistance, prophylaxis and major diagnostic issues).
- 7. Students who will get grade average \geq 4.8 from both semesters and pass very well the practical exam will be released from the final exam and will get grade 5 from microbiology.
- 8. The final exam covers material from the 1st and 2nd semester of microbiology.
