Rules for the safety and convenience of everyone working in the laboratory:

- 1. Keep silence during classes to not disturb other students.
- 2. Eating, drinking are forbidden in the laboratory.
- **3.** Long hair must be tied up and this is a student's responsibility as cases of burning hair from the burner were recorded.
- 4. Student bags must not be placed on the floor in the laboratory.
- 5. Pencils, labels or any other materials should never be placed into mouth.
- 6. Transfer needles and loops are sterilized by heating the entire length of the wire to redness <u>before and after using</u>.
- 7. If bacterial culture will spill off, cover the area with disinfectant and notify the instructor.
- 8. It is not allowed to take bacterial cultures from the laboratory.
- 9. Inoculated media placed in the incubator must be properly labeled i.e. with name, date, and the nature of the specimen, and put on the assigned shelf.
- **10.**Gas burners must be turned off when not in use during the laboratory period. Be sure gas burners are turned off at the end of the laboratory period.
- **11.** Eyepiece, lenses, and objectives should be cleaned after use. Immersion oil must by wiped off from the lenses of the microscope with lens paper.
- 12. All reagents and equipment must be turned to their proper place at the end of each laboratory period.
- **13.** All tubes, Petri dishes etc. must be disposed into sterilization cans at the end of the laboratory period.
- 14. All scraps of paper, cotton, etc. must be placed into wastebaskets and not left on desk tops or on the floor.
- 15. Personal accidents, such as cuts, burns must be reported immediately to the instructor.
- 16. Every student should wash his/her hands with a soap and then with a disinfectant before leaving the laboratory.
