STUDY REGULATIONS

OF DIDACTICS IN HISTOLOGY AND EMBRYOLOGY DEPARTMENT FOR I YEAR OF MEDICINE AND DENTISTRY

I. GENERAL RULES

- 1. Information relating to the courses that take place in Histology and Embryology Department is announced on the notice boards (on the ground floor next to the entrance door of Histology and Embryology Dept. and in classrooms) and on the website (https://www.umw.edu.pl/pl/jednostki/zaklad-histologii-i-embriologii).
- 2. Classes and seminars are conducted in Histology and Embryology Department, lectures are on-line.
- 3. Lectures, seminars are conducted according to the plan, punctually of the scheduled time.
- 4. Attendance of courses covered by the study plans shall be mandatory and monitored. **An absence must be excused complemented with a relevant document** (a medical certificate from a doctor) which should be delivered to the teacher immediately after returning from the seek leave (the first class after an absence). If a student is absent from any class (seminar), this class must be compensated for after returning from the absence or during the special 'make-up' classes.
- 5. Any transfers to another group requires written permission of:
- a) Histology and Embryology Dept. ED Courses Coordinator,
- b) Tutor of the year.

- 6. During histology classes each student is responsible for the assigned microscope and microscopic slides.
- 8. To get credit from histology student has to:
- a) take part in microscopic exercises,
- b) make drawings from microscopic observations,
- c) answer to the questions (oral or written).
- 9. The basis for received of credit **WINTER semester** (1st semester, 1st year):
- a) credit from histology classes,
- b) credit from general histology test.
- 10. The basis for received of credit **SUMMER semester** (2nd semester, 1st year):
- a) credit from histology classes,
- b) credit from practical histology test,
- c) credit from cytophysiology seminars/or test
- 11. Conditions of credit for Medicine

If a student has more than <u>3 no credits (winter semester) or 2 no credits (summer semester)</u> he/she receives conditional credit

12. Conditions of credit for **Dentistry**

If a student has more than <u>3 no credits (winter semester) or 2 no credits (summer semester)</u> he/she receives conditional credit.

- 13. General rules for **Histology course** are included in the **syllabus of the subject for AY 2023/2024**: Medicine "Histology with cytophysiology" Dentistry "Histology with embryology"
- 14. General rules for Embryology seminars are included in the syllabus of the subject for AY 2023/2024
- 15. <u>Final exam</u> from "Histology with cytophysiology" (Medicine) and "Histology with embryology" (Dentistry) is in the form of the test after the second semester (I year)

Conditions to participate in the final exam:

- a) credit from histology classes,
- b) passed practical test from histology (slides recognition),
- c) credit from all cytophysiology seminars/ or test.

II. STUDENTS RIGHTS

Students have right to:

- 1. Submit some comments and suggestions according to organization, form and manner of teaching rules.
- 2. Ask tutor about learning subject.

III. STUDENTS RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Students are required to complete workplace safety training and compliance with its principles.
- 2. Students are required to attend and actively participate in all classes.
- 3. Students must be prepared to each class or seminar according to the provided plan.
