## REGULATIONS OF SUBJECTS CONDUCTED IN THE TRAUMATOLOGY DEPARTMENT AND EMERGENCY MEDICINE OF DEVELOPMENTAL AGE street Chałubińskiego 3 in Wrocław

All classes at our Department are held in accordance with the subject schedule, at the hours provided for in the class schedule. The student is obliged to participate in classes with the student group to which he or she is assigned.

Before classes, students are obliged to leave their outer clothing in the cloakroom. The classes include lectures, seminars, non-clinical exercises, clinical exercises and exercises in simulated conditions.

During the first classes, the teachers present detailed conditions for passing the exam, in accordance with the syllabus of a given subject.

Attendance at all lectures, seminars and exercises is mandatory. In case of absence, the student is obliged to make up these classes.

The form of making up classes (oral assessment of the missed material/making up classes with another group/essay/presentation) and the date must be agreed with the person teaching the course. The student is obliged to make up all absences in the same semester in which he missed classes.

After each semester, the person responsible for the course will receive attendance lists and a list of students who have not met the above-mentioned conditions on the basis of which it is possible to pass the course.

Each student is obliged to keep the premises of our Institute clean and tidy. Eating meals and talking on a mobile phone are prohibited during classes. Smoking is strictly prohibited on the premises of the Plant.

The exercises take place in the Medical Simulation Center, in the Emergency Department (ED) of the Medical University Hospital at ul. Borowska 213 and on the premises of the Department at ul. Chałubińskiego 3.

During the exercises, practical procedures given in the class timetable are discussed and performed.

Clinical exercises take place under the supervision of a teacher using medical simulation techniques. In order to increase the effectiveness of participation in the exercises, students are required to prepare a given topic before starting the exercises.

The use of any form of photo documentation, including video recordings, is prohibited within the CSM and in the hospital.

## **PASSING SUBJECTS**

Detailed conditions for obtaining credit for individual subjects conducted by the Department of Traumatology and Emergency Medicine of the Developmental Age are provided in the syllabi.
