

SAFETY REGULATIONS FOR BIOPHYSICS LABORATORY PRACTICALS

1. All electronic equipment must be operated with care. Never touch electric cables or any equipment powered by an electric current with wet hands. Be careful when un-plugging an electronic device from a socket.
2. In case of an electric shock turn off the electric power supply and get the sufferer away from the source of the shock. Call a medical assistance.
3. All chemicals must be stored in closed containers. Open a container just before you use a chemical and close it immediately after the use. In case of any contact with a chemical, immediately wash a site of the contact with a proper amount of water.
4. Never expose your eyes to a laser light beam.
5. Any injuries caused by a broken glass or anything else must be reported to a tutor immediately.
6. Any damage or loss of function of a laboratory equipment must be reported to a tutor. Never try to repair a laboratory equipment on your own.
7. Performing some experiments may not be recommended for people with epilepsy or during pregnancy, so you should inform the instructor about this fact during the introductory classes.
