ANNOTATION

The Erasmus+ values introduced in 2021 play a significant role in elevating the programme to a new level, with the potential to make a profound impact on future society. However, due to the broad definitions of these priorities, it can sometimes be challenging to effectively communicate the values of inclusion, sustainability, digitalization, and civic engagement to students and staff on an individual level. In this BIP, we will learn from one another how to integrate concrete initiatives and activities at the institutional level, so they can organically support and complement the mobility of both outgoing and incoming participants.

The BIP consists of two main parts:

1) a training part based on lectures given by Charles University experts and 2) an interactive part consisting of good practice sharing, ideas exchange, and vivid discussions. In addition, an informal network will be established to foster stronger cooperation for future Erasmus+ priorities development.
