All courses here are confirmed as "credit with mark". You can find in our curriculum description : "GRADE" - it means lectures and classes credited with mark and sometimes additionally "EXAM" it means final exam (not all our courses finish with exam) Optional courses might (!) be available (1 optional/semester). However, there is certain number of students required to form the group and if the group is completed additional students cannot be accepted. Furthermore, I call your attention that elective courses are available to limited number of students and are not always started. We cannot guarantee that you can join those courses! It is possible to apply for 1 or 2 optional subjects !

In 2020/2021 our curriculum should change for 5th yr .: We expect that Neonatology, Public Health, Medical Law will appear and ECTS for other subjects will be little changed.

Curriculum for 2020/2021 should be announced in may or june 2020. To prepare your proposed LA (Learning agreement) please follow 2019/2020 curriculum

Here we have only General Surgery (not gastrointestinal, thoraco, cardio)

You can put into Your learning agreement our 1-5 yr subjects and optimally (to avoid overlapping) is not to takeing different year level courses .

To obtain whole subject ECTS (in year)subject like surgery, internal disease, paediatrics should be taken in totality during winter and summer semester. It is possible to take selected parts of internal diseases 4th and 5th yr but it'll give proportionally less ECTS

Clinical rotations (traineeship program)

In the academic year 2017/2018 our new study program was implemented on the 6 yr (as practical year) and that's why we have limited possibilities to accept students for many courses, especially internship program. In this situation we do not recommend to take here internship program longer than 2 months.

In practice all members of our didactic staff participate in regular didactic activity (ED and Polish classes, lectures, seminars) and it is very difficult to fix clinical rotations in the days of classes. We must look for not overcrowded clinics to find a place for rotation and it means that it is not possible to fulfill strictly detailed students needs. Our University standard is 2 months traineeship program (maximal 3 months) and for incoming students with long traineeship program we can offer our regular 6 yr program (in ED/Erasmus groups – whole semester program).
