Optional courses might (!) be available (1 optional/semester). However, there is certain number of students required to form the group and if the group is completed additional students cannot be accepted. These courses are rather confirmed as "credited without mark". We have many other courses credited without mark in our curriculum (!) and if You want to have final grade You must explain this problem with Tutors after arrival.

Furthermore, I call your attention that elective courses are available to a limited number of students and are not always started. We cannot guarantee that you can join those courses! It is possible to apply for 1 or 2 optionals!

In 2018/2019 our curriculum should change for 3rd yr ("modified program"): we expect that for example that 2nd part of Pathomorphology and Microbiology courses will appear. Public health, Genetics, Tuberculosis in 2018/2019 will be not available here!

You can put into Your learning agreement our 1-5 yr subjects and optimal (to avoid overlapping) is not to take different year level courses.

To get full ECTS subject points you need to accomplish a complete package of subject. It refers to the following subjects (surgery, internal diseases, pediatrics) If You decide to take selected parts only you will receive proportionally less ECTS.

Clinical rotations (traineeship program)

In the academic year 2017/2018 our new study program was implemented on the 6 yr (as practical year) and that's why we have limited possibilities to accept students for many courses, especially internship program. In this situation we do not recommend to take here internship program longer than 2 months.

In practice all members of our didactic stuff participate in regular didactic activity (ED and Polish classes, lectures, seminars) and it is very difficult to fix clinical rotations in the days of classes. We must look for not overcrowded clinics to find a place for rotation and it means that it is not possible to fulfill strictly detailed students needs. Our University standard is 2 months traineeship program (maximal 3 months) and for incoming students with long traineeship program we can offer our regular 6 yr program (in ED/Erasmus groups – whole semester program).
