

The Wroclaw Medical University has participated in the Erasmus+ programme since the academic year 1998/1999. We collaborate with 70 universities from 18 European countries. We accept around 100 international students and send more then 150 our students abroad each year. The language of instruction is mainly Polish however the students who are willing to study medicine or dentistry may join classes at the English Division.

General Information

Application Procedure:

We need the nomination of the Home University first. Once we receive the list of nominated students, we will contact them and let them know about all necessary documents to be completed.

Students are asked to complete the forms, print and ask authorized people to sign them and send their scanned version to:

- Please do not send the documents by post or by fax. We will only accept papers sent by e-mail. Once we receive all necessary scanned documents and our faculties coordinators accept the proposed Learning agreement for studies /traineeships, we will send a copy of signed document back to the student. Students will get the information package at their address.
- Please make sure that upon arrival you have got: one photo,
 - digital photo (to be sent to

- copy of identity document,
- certificate of your Erasmus+ status (issued by Erasmus office of home university), health insurance (European Health Insurance Card EHIC or any relevant one) and accident insurance,

- liability insurance (optional for studies, mandatory for traineeships).
- For safety reasons we suggest you also bring:
- health certificate (with information about hepatitis B)

How to arrive

There are several possibilities how to arrive to Wrocław:

By plane

Copernicus Airport Wroclaw is located southwest of the city, about 10 km from the centre.

You can get there by bus or by taxi. Bus No.106 operates every 20 minutes everyday

to/from the Central Railway. Night bus No.206 operates twice during the night to/from the Central Railway.

By train

The central railway station is situated in the city centre (Józef Piłsudski Street). It has direct connections with all major cities of Poland and several cities of Europe. The timetable is available at www.pkp.pl.

By bus

The central bus station is located at the back of the central railway station. It serves intercity lines as well as local ones. Buses of companies transporting passengers to/from all major European cities stop there as well.
