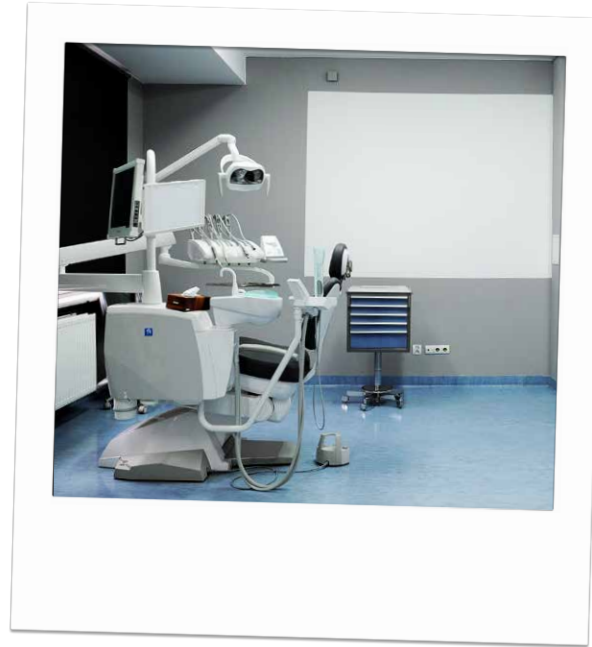

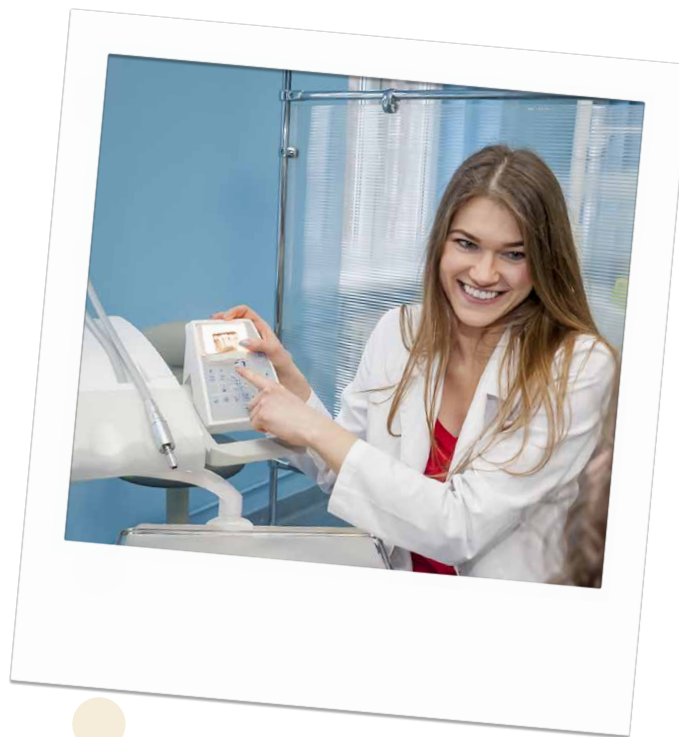
5-YEAR MASTERS DEGREE STUDIES

The studies focus on gaining practical knowledge in the field of dentistry and also teach the basis of medicine like Anatomy or Biology. At Wroclaw Medical University, the curriculum nurtures an environment not to only learn but also offers great opportunities to apply your knowledge and develop your manual skills. Lecturers are friendly and serve as role models for students with their positive attitudes and professionalism.

The first two years of the studies are mainly focused on theory and everyone acquires basic scientific knowledge of the field. As you begin third year, lecturers start focusing on the clinical side of dentistry and classes are held with patients.



Courses are taught in English, however, it does not hinder us from communicating with the patients. Because Polish is one of the mandatory subjects, everyone can learn it, so it doesn't become a language barrier. Additionally if anyone runs into difficulties, a teacher is available to conduct an interview with the patient and can outline what needs to be done.



I come from the USA and I chose to study Dentistry in Wroclaw because I consider it the most beautiful city in Poland. Additionally, my parents studied at this university and I wanted to follow in their footsteps.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

There are no entrance exams to Wroclaw Medical University, Recruitment requires submitting results from three subjects:

- CHEMISTRY
- BIOLOGY
- PHYSICS OR MATHEMATICS.

Admission is based on an open competition of grades on the high school certificate. All candidates applying for a place at the University are asked to register in Online Registration System (IRK). Link to the System is available on our website: www.ed.umed.wroc.pl

During this stage of admission the candidates are required to submit documents such as:

1. High School Diploma with transcript of grades - which qualifies a candidate to undertake higher education studies at university level in the country of issue
2. English Language Certificate - if your mother language is not English, e.g. IELTS, TOEFL.
3. Copy of passport or another personal ID
4. Health Certificate – stating that the candidate is in good condition to start medical studies. Filled and signed by a doctor.
5. Application Form – signed by the candidate.
